### **MOVE-UPS (TRANSFERS)**

Day-of-trial move-ups will be accepted at the trial all three days. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes before the beginning of the trial (start time for the first class of the day).

Move-ups will also be accepted no later than 30 minutes after the last class of the day on Friday and Saturday.

## **ENTRY OF INELIGIBLE “A” DOG**

A dog which has been entered in an “A” class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions of the dog or handler, may be moved to the “B” class at the same level under the following conditions: 1) The request must state the reason and justification for the move from an “A” class to the “B” class within the level. 2) The request must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least thirty minutes prior to the start of each trial.

## **IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:**

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraphy entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **or without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

**Entry Fees** will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

**The Hurricane Ridge Kennel Club and City of Sequim**, assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such a case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

**All dogs** must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up areas.

**The safety of dogs is a primary concern.** By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.**

**ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ENTERED AND ELIGIBLE** to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

## **DIRECTIONS TO CARRIE BLAKE PARK BASEBALL FIELD:**

FROM THE EAST: Exit Hwy 101 at Washington Street and continue west about 1 mile, turn right on Blake Ave. Go about 300 yards, turn right into grounds for RV (overnight) and day of show parking.

**EXHIBITORS STAYING IN LOCAL HOTELS:**

We do not have a large quantity of hotel rooms in this area. Therefore, maintaining a good relationship with those that will accept dogs is **CRITICAL** to YOU, our exhibitors. To help ensure that we have hotels that will accept dogs in the future, the following policies are now in effect and will be strictly enforced. Violation of these policies may result in an HRKC/AKC Bench Hearing.

**IF YOU PLAN TO STAY IN A HOTEL AND TAKE YOUR DOG INTO THE ROOM:**

- **Contact** the **Hotel DIRECTLY** to make your reservation. Indicate you require a “dog room” – DO NOT use a third-party reservation service.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO BATHING OF DOGS** is allowed in **ANY** of the guest rooms, guest room bathrooms or bathtubs
- Dogs **MUST** be on a leash in public areas of the hotel at all times.
- Dogs **MUST** be exercised in the designated dog area.
- You **MUST pick up** after your dog! **DO NOT** allow your dog to urinate on buildings, garbage cans, etc.
- **NO DOGS** are to be left **UNATTENDED** in guest rooms at **ANY TIME!**
- No dogs are allowed IN or ON beds.
- Dogs that are excessively barking must be removed from the premises in respect of the other guests in the hotel.
- **DO NOT** take dogs into non-dog allotted rooms. This creates problems for people with allergies and requires special post-dog cleaning.
